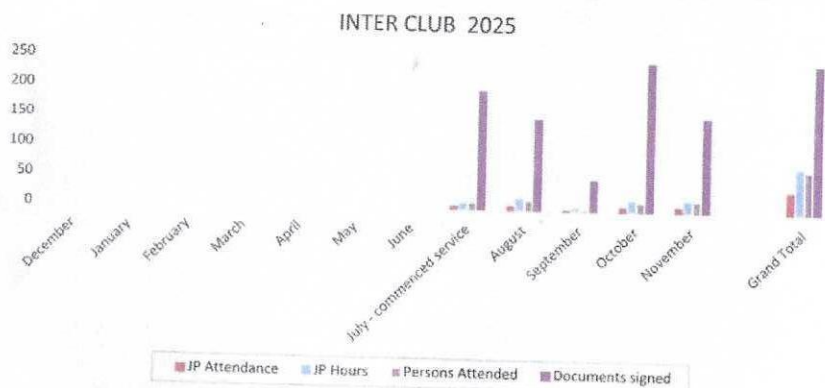


JP article
